A bit of clarification on the below.

The Consortium for Electronic Literature (founded by the ELO, currently with ten members including the ELO) is currently working on the first web-based search engine for works of e-lit. The development is taking place at the NT2 lab at UQAM (Montreal). All the CELL members are seeking funds from their institutions to help fund this development. Currently, the following members have committed funds:

- \* ELO, budgeted [REDACTED] for CELL in its budget
- \* ELMCIP, budgeted [REDACTED]
- \* Siegen, budgeted approximately [REDACTED]

Since NT2 is not yet ready to receive the funds, the ELO agreed to act as the intermediary, essentially acting as the CELL's bank. We recently sent an invoice to ELMCIP requesting their funds be transferred to the ELO bank account.
